



Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP)

Required Document Checklist: YOUNGER YOUTH

14-15 Years Old

If you are selected from the lottery or recruited for a summer opportunity, you will need to bring certain documents to your SYEP provider. You must submit **COPIES** of one (1) item from categories 1-6 listed below as it applies to you. <u>These items are needed to officially complete your enrollment so that you are eligible for SYEP.</u> Note that some documents may satisfy more than one category (e.g. U.S. Birth Certificate or current U.S. Passport for categories 2).

Reminder: ONLY COPIES OF THESE DOCUMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED
