Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP)

Items Needed

Getting paid by direct deposit is fast and easy! To sign up, you will need your Bank's routing number, your savings or checking account number, account type and the name of your bank. Be sure to secure this information before you get started.

- 1. Bank's Routing Number (9-digit number)
- 2. Bank Account Number (Account numbers vary by bank)
- 3. Bank Account Type (Checking or Savings)
- 4. Name of Bank (Chase, Bank of America, Santander, etc.)
- 5. Please make sure your account is still active before signing up!

Introducing Split Payments

You now have the option to have your pay direct deposited into one or two bank accounts. By splitting your pay into two deposits, you can send a portion of your pay to savings.



Getting Started

The deadline to sign up for direct deposit is June 30th at 11:59pm. You will only have one chance to sign up, so please be sure to enter your correct information.


Participants: Please make sure to enter the correct bank routing number and savings or checking account number in order to request direct deposit service. If you have questions, please check with your financial institution to be sure you have the correct information and your account is active prior to signing up for direct deposit. If the information you provide is incorrect, and we are unable to deposit funds into your account, you will be paid via a payroll card. You may sign up to have funds deposited into two accounts. However, if we are unable to deposit funds into one of these accounts, all funds will be sent to the alternate account. If we are unable to deposit funds into both accounts, you will be paid via payroll card. If you would like to cancel your direct deposit at any time, please let your Provider know. You will be paid via a payroll card.
